OVERALL MINISTRY FUNCTIONS:

The overall functions of the Ministry of Mines and Mining Development are to:

- Administer the Mines and Minerals Act [Chapter 21:05];
- Formulate, monitor and evaluate implementation of mining development policies;
- Design mechanisms geared at effective accounting for the country's mineral resources;
- Administer and review mining and explosives laws;
- Develop and maintain an up-to-date data bank on present/future mineral deposits;
- Attract investment in the mining industry;
- Promote beneficiation and value addition of mineral resources;
- Promote and develop small-scale mining;
- Facilitate involvement and participation of indigenous Zimbabweans in the mining sector;
- Monitor and undertake exploration activities across the country; and
- Supervise and coordinate mining parastatals and state enterprises.
